FORMS OF WATER

Key terms:

Evaporation – Change of water into water vapour on heating is called evaporation.

Condensation – Change of water vapour into water on cooling is called condensation.

Freezing – Change of water into ice on cooling is called freezing.

Melting – Change of ice into water on heating is called melting.

1. Why do clothes dry faster in the sun?

Ans. Clothes dry faster in the sun because water from clothes changes into water vapour due to sun's heat

2. What are the three forms of water?

Ans. The three forms of water are-

- i. Ice
- ii. Water
- iii. Water vapour (steam)

3. What is melting?

Ans. Change of ice into water on heating is called melting.

4. What is Condensation?

Ans. Change of water vapour into water on cooling is called condensation.

5. What is water cycle?

Ans. Water cycle is the journey of water from the earth to the sky and again to the earth.
