- There is neither air nor water on the moon.



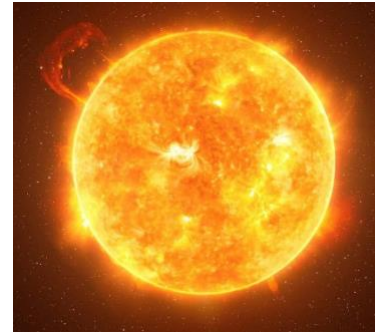
### **The Stars**
